The Physics Auxiliary Publication Service (EPAPS) is an electronic depository for material that is supplemental to papers appearing in journals published by or through the American Institute of Physics. Appropriate materials for deposit are either those that intrinsically require electronic media (e.g., multimedia files) or those of too limited reader interest to warrant the number of pages required for publication in the journal. Suitable EPAPS material include multimedia (e.g., movie files, audio files, 3D rendering files), color figures, computer programs, data tables, and text (e.g., appendices). Materials are accessed by users via links from the online journal (see <http://scitation.aip.org>) or via the EPAPS homepage (see <http://www.aip.org/pubservs/epaps.html>).

1 How to Deposit

Materials submitted for deposit should be **submitted to the JOURNAL EDITOR** along with a completed EPAPS Deposit Form (see reverse). After acceptance by the journal editor, the editor forwards to AIP the EPAPS form, signed by both the author and the editor. Upon receipt of the accepted manuscript and deposit form, AIP will assign an EPAPS deposit number and will send the author specific instructions for transferring the electronic files. Several sets of files (i.e., several distinct supplements) related to the *same article* should be combined into a single deposit, which will be given a single EPAPS number. There are no restrictions on the format of the electronic files; **hardcopy materials are not accepted for deposit**.

2 Deposit Fees

In most cases, there is no charge to the author for depositing supplemental files with EPAPS. Deposits consisting of excessive numbers of files or excessively high file sizes may be rejected or may incur deposit fees. Direct questions to epaps@aip.org.

3 Storage and Retrieval

After receipt of the material and deposit form, AIP will assign an EPAPS deposit number that will be referenced in the journal article and identify the deposit online.

Once deposited, materials are available to users online. For many of the online journals available on AIP's *Scitation*[®] platform (<http://scitation.aip.org>), prominent links in the online article allow users to navigate directly to the associated EPAPS deposit. In addition, EPAPS deposits may be retrieved by users free of charge via the EPAPS homepage (<http://www.aip.org/pubservs/epaps.html>).

Authors must add a citation within the original paper's reference section that will refer to the deposited supplemental material as follows:

AIP staff will fill in the EPAPS Document Number; the Author must provide a *brief description* of the material.
