I. GROUP ONE: Kalamazoo College study abroad programs approved for transfer of academic credit and Kalamazoo financial aid/scholarships. These programs have a local Resident Director, established program excursions; group transportation from arrival airport to housing; and dedicated on-site support for Kalamazoo students. In most cases, the CIP will assist students during the pre-departure process, including processing required documents and student visa applications.

** The Kalamazoo Comprehensive Fee for study abroad includes: tuition and fees, food and housing while classes are in session, and round-trip international airfare from the designated point of departure, typically New York, Miami, or Los Angeles. Not included: books, personal spending money, food or housing during vacation periods or after classes have ended, and independent travel. Fees for participation in programs not sponsored by Kalamazoo College may be higher than the Kalamazoo fee, due to higher operating costs, fluctuation in the exchange rate between the U.S. dollar and the foreign currency, or for any other reasons beyond the control of Kalamazoo College. Indications of additional charges for such programs are given for purposes of illustration only and may not reflect the actual comprehensive fee assessed. In no instance will participants in programs not sponsored by Kalamazoo College pay less than the fee assessed participants in Kalamazoo College programs. Typically, the Center for International Programs publishes the list of study abroad comprehensive fees for the next academic year in the spring term.

Students wishing to petition for one-time only approval of transfer of credit for a study abroad program not listed above, must file their petition by December 1. Details and instructions are available in the CIP. Programs approved through petition are not eligible for transfer of Kalamazoo financial assistance/scholarships.
